REGISTRATION OF YOUR PROPERTY WITH MIDVAAL

It remains the responsibility of the OWNER to register your property with Midvaal for rates, taxes, sewer & refuse billing. You will need to supply proof of ownership of the property - Erf number: 2516 / (Unit number).

REFUSE COLLECTION & RECYCLING

Refuse bins will be placed in the refuse areas and you are required by the BC rules, to put your refuse in black bags into the bins. Midvaal Municipality only collects black bags every Friday and a company sorts the recycling.

INFORMATION REGARDING LIVING IN A SECTIONAL TITLE SCHEME

The Body Corporate is overseen by a Board of Trustees that were nominated and voted in by the residents. They have a fiduciary duty to uphold the standards within the estate and ensure the financial health of the complex.

The external maintenance of the communal areas including the external of each block, the boundary walls, carports, parks within Haymarket and the dustbin areas is what you pay a portion of your levy towards. The Body Corporate is responsible for using the levy for this maintenance.

The Gardens of each unit are classed as exclusive use areas and the garden service, and maintenance of these areas is also for the Body Corporates responsibilities and comes out of your levies.

The internal area of each unit, including the patios & balconies, the painting, tiling and general upkeep are the OWNERS responsibility and are for the owners account solely after handover and registration.

Any and all renovations, aircon installs, patio adjustments and others must be cleared with the BC first before any work is started.

General noise and estate complaints must be addressed to security or the HOA as this does not form part of the Body Corporates responsibility.
